The Bingo cards on the next few pages can be printed out onto card and laminated or encapsulated to be used over and over again. To mark the objects use a wax crayon or non permanent marker that can be wiped off.

Game 1

A non driving adult has the check list and acts as caller using the checklists provided, the winner is the first to get five in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally. You can play this as one off games or best of 5 and because each part of the journey is different you can either keep your cards or pass it on to the person on your right depending on how the boss (usually the caller) feels.

Game 2

Everyone has a card and the winner is the first to complete the whole card...this only works if you have a nice honest family who don't cheat!...thats us out then!

Game 3

Pick a row on your card and tell everyone which one it is. Starting with the passenger sitting behind the driver and going clockwise each player has so many miles or minutes to try and find something on their line and tick it off. This can be altered to suit the age of the children and the speed of the journey. On a motorway 1 mile will whizz past but in traffic it may take hours, especially if its a bank holiday weekend!

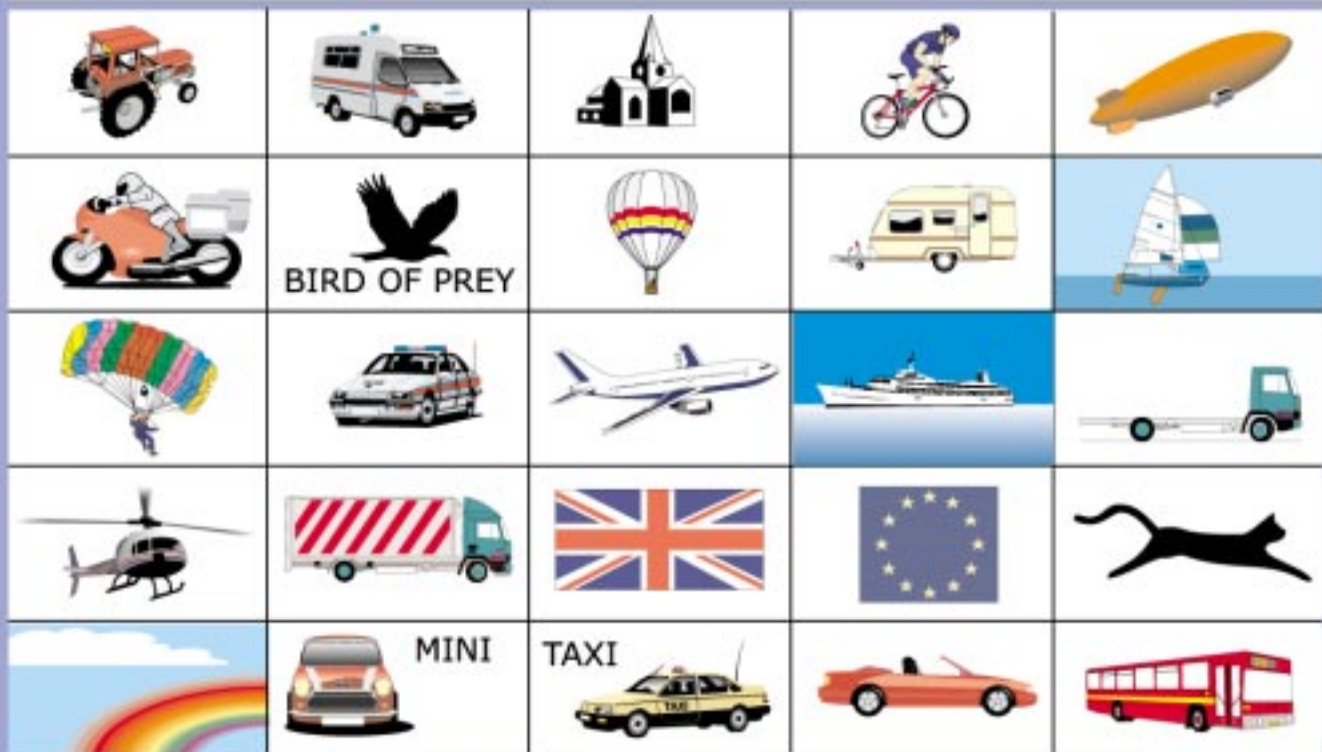

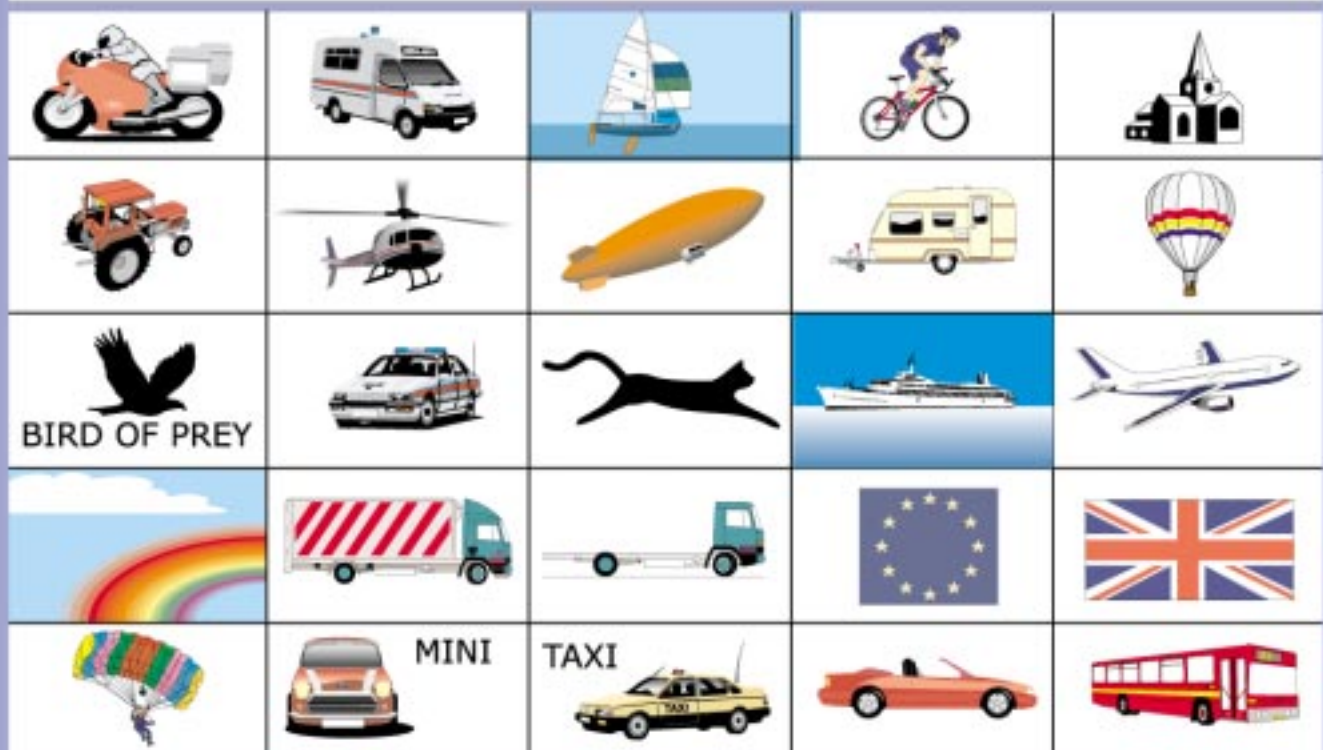

FIRST TO 50

Print out the following sheet and either give one to all the passengers playing or put it somewhere in the car where everyone can see it.

Game 1

Ignore the empty squares on the bottom of the sheet

Take it in turns, starting the the person in the front passenger seat and go clockwise.

In the countryside where there is little traffic each player scores on the 'next car' however when its busy the player has the car immediately behind the next silver car.

The scores can be doubled up so for example if someone got a lorry or van with a euro plate they would get 30 points. The winner is the first to get 50 points

Game 2

This is played the same as above but to make it more fun and make the game last longer, at the bottom of the sheet are some empty squares for you to colour in and so choose extra points and penalties using your own coloured cars or objects if you prefer.

The 'have a sweet' square is a bonus square and scores no points it should however be something fairly rare otherwise you'll end up with the whole car being sick!!

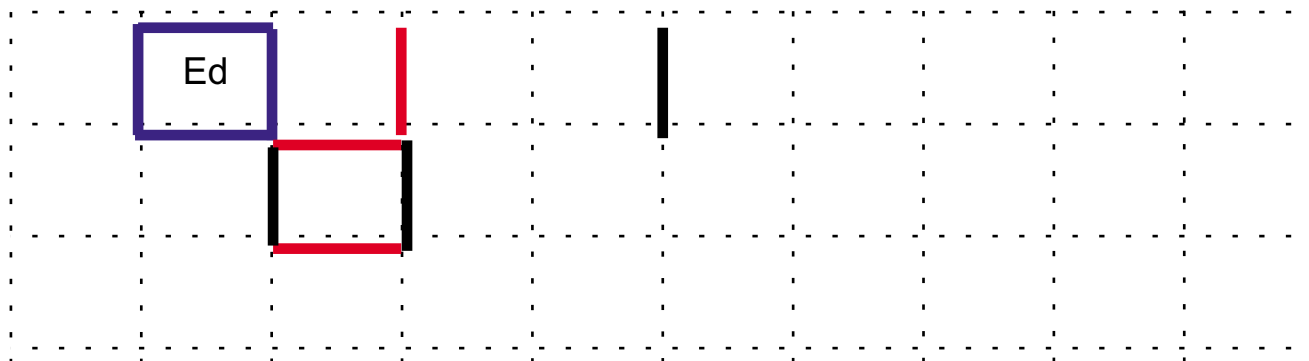

Print out the following sheet and either give one to all the passengers playing

Game 1

Everyone has a pen or pencil and takes it in turn to try and create a square one line at a time. Everytime anyone makes a square they put their initials in it and have another go. See the example below, Ed is blue, Rich is red and Charlie is black...the winner is the one with the most squares once the sheet is filled. Ed goes first with a blue line...



Game 2

The cards on page are dealt between the passengers and every time they see one of them they get to make:

- 1 line for a green card
- 2 lines for a blue card
- 3 lines for a yellow card but miss the next go

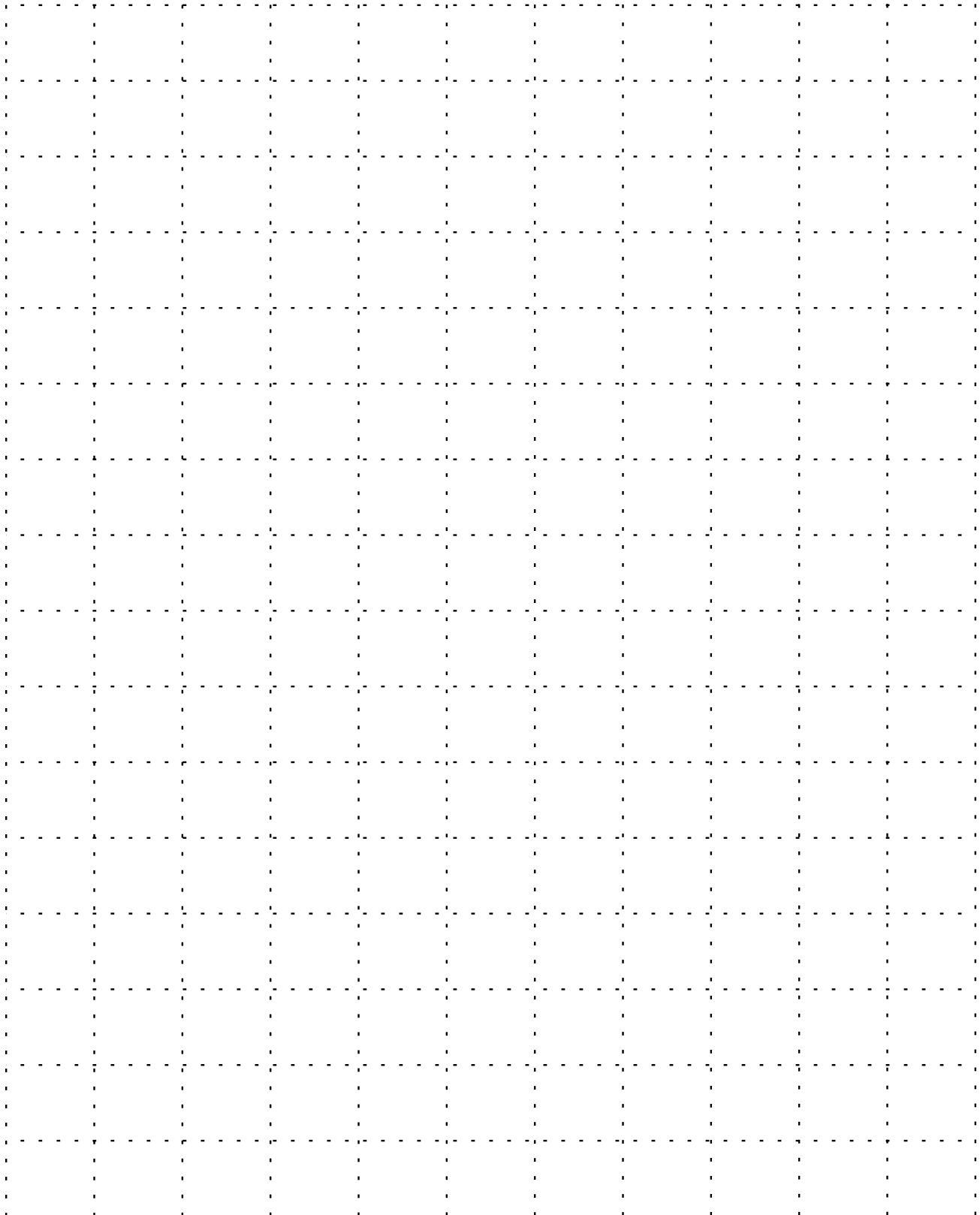
For added fun if you have the card with the white dot on and see it you get a treat from the driver

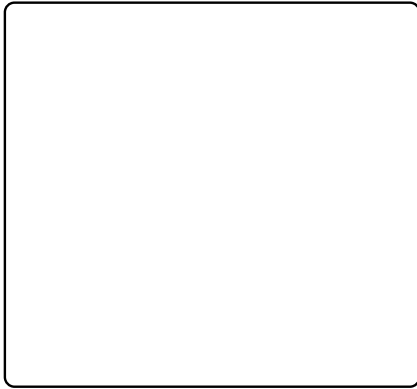
Print out the following sheet and either give one to all the passengers playing.

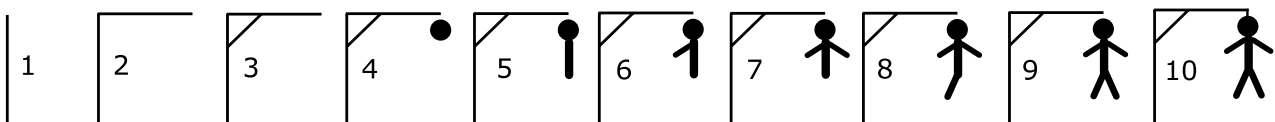

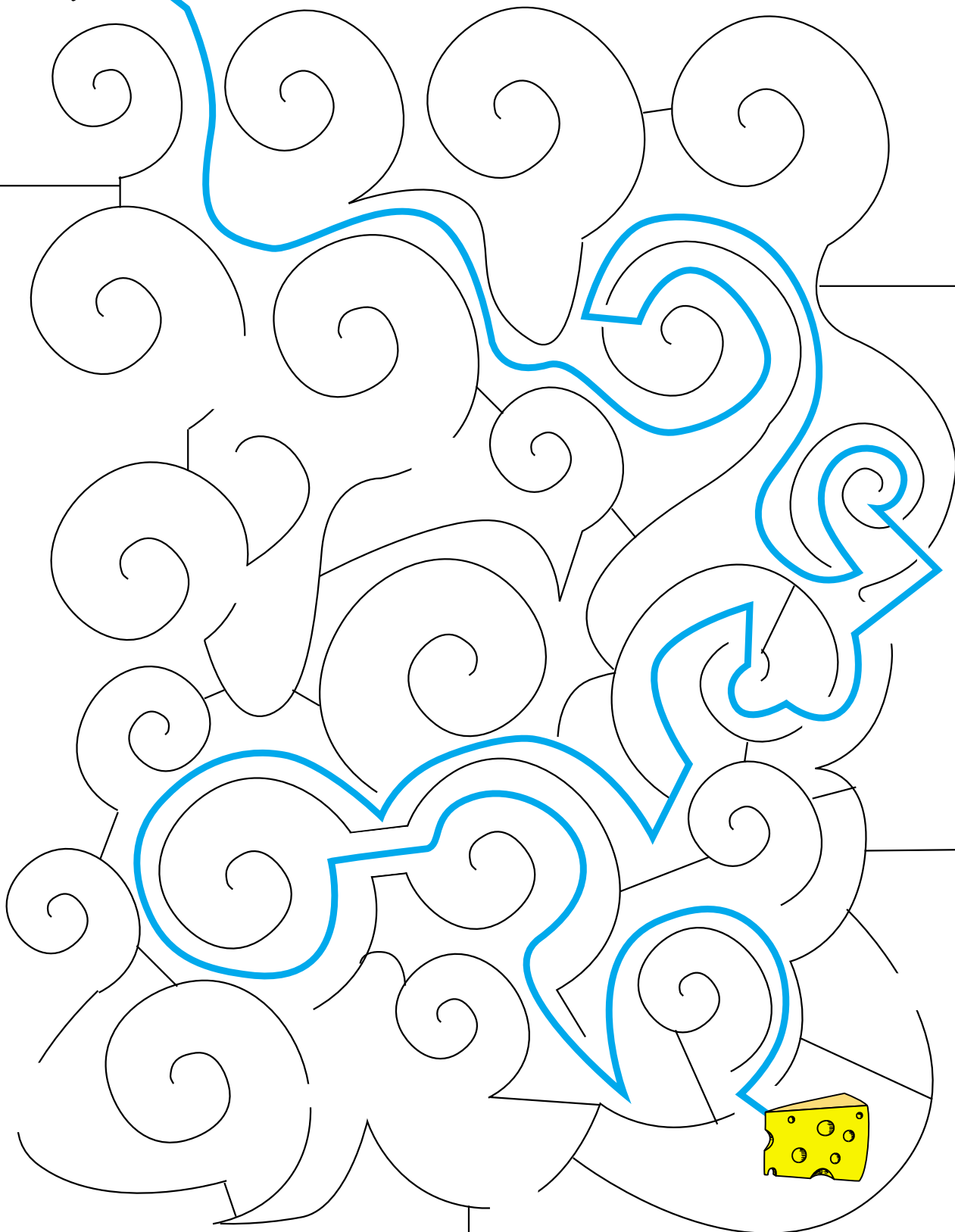

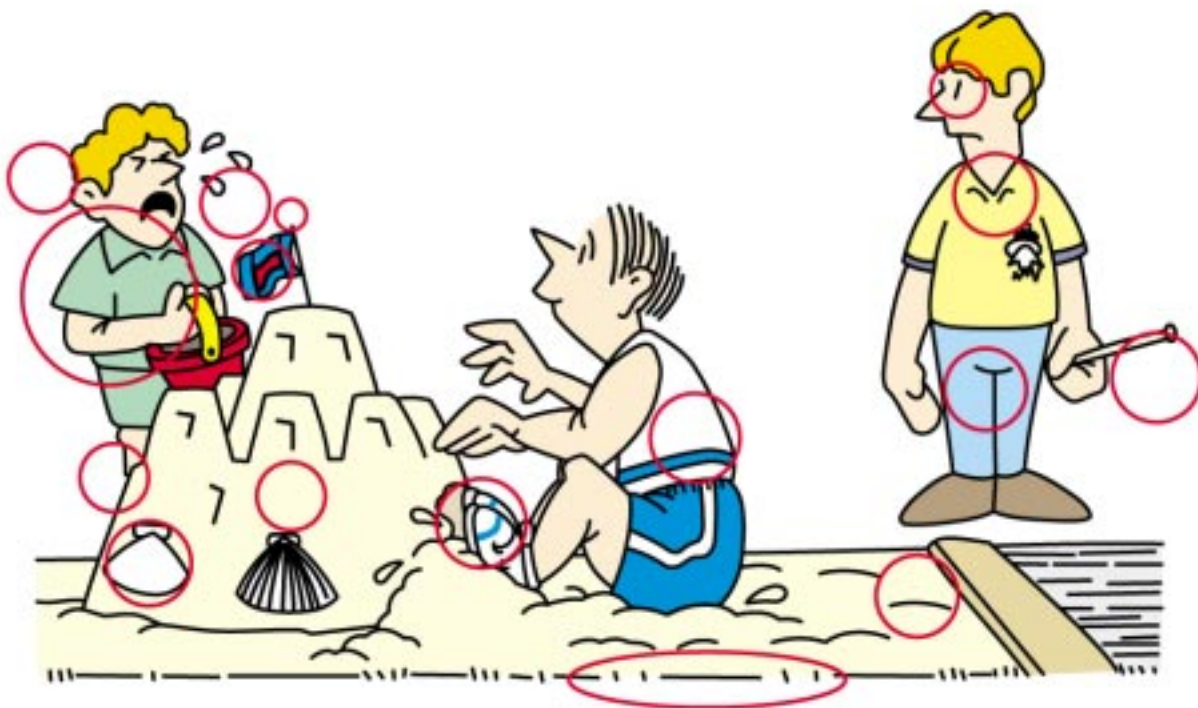
